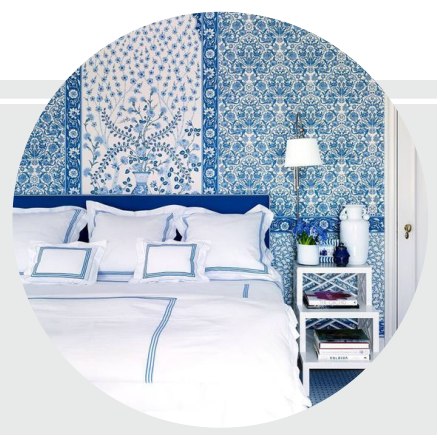


# Preparing for Houseguests

- Make sure your guest bed has clean linens, fluffy pillows and a warm duvet or blanket
- Clear the dresser and closet and fill it with hangers
- Place a sachet in the dresser or closet
- Leave magazines and books on the nightstand and place the remote in the drawer
- Double check that all of the lights in the guest room work and replace any light bulbs if necessary
- Fill the house – including the guest room and guest bathroom – with fresh flowers
- Stock the guest bathroom with plenty of clean towels, a plush robe, soaps, bubble bath, shampoo and conditioner, disposable razors, shaving cream, toothbrushes, toothpaste, cotton balls, q-tips, toilet paper, lotion and a hair dryer and brush
- Stock your fridge and pantry with the basics and anything special you know they like.
- Check with your guest to see if they have any dietary restrictions too
